

With great pleasure, we announce the outstanding exam results of the IBDP Batch of 2022 – 2024!

Their dedication, hard work, and perseverance have truly paid off, and we could not be more proud of their achievements. The average global pass rate is 80%. We have 17 students who have graduated with an IB Diploma and one with an IBCertificate.

The following is a summary of the average grade of NIS students in comparison with world average grades. The highest grade achievable in every subject is a 7 and the highest total available for a Diploma Programme student is 45 points. It is our pleasure to state that this year, we have 6 students (from a batch of 18 students) who have scored 40 points and above. Against the world average of 30.32 points obtained by students to attain the Diploma, NIS students have achieved an average of 35 points.

In *English*, NIS students have achieved an average grade of 5.67, against a world average of 4.72 at HL, and 5.08, against the world average of 4.91 at SL. For French, students have scored an incredible average grade of 7, as compared to the world average of 4.71 at Abinitio. and 6.67, against the world average of 5.1 at French B-SL. Spanish averaged 5.5 against a world average of 4.92.

ESS (Environmental Systems and Societies) students scored a high average of 6 as against a world average of 4.19. Global Politics has also scored a stellar average grade of 6, against the world average of 4.76 at SL and a 6 again against the global average of 5.02 at HL. Psychology has averaged at 5.14 against the world average of 4.74 at HL and 5.75 against the world average of 4.41.

Mathematics AA students scored a wonderful average grade of 5.29 against a world average of 4.86. Mathematics AI students have achieved a whopping average grade of 6.00 as opposed to a world average of 3.92 at SL and 5.17 against the world average of 4.40 at HL.

Economics HL students have achieved an average of 5.67 against a world average of 5.12; whereas **Economics SL** has averaged at a phenomenal 7 against the world 4.8. **Business** Of Management too at HL has averaged at **7** against the world average of 4.89 and at SL, our students have averaged at 5.67 against the world average of 4.89.

Coming to the Sciences, for Biology (HL), the NIS student average grade is **5.00**, higher than the world average of 4.41, and at SL, the NIS average grade is 5.25 against the world average of 4.18. Chemistry is much higher than the average, NIS – **6.50** as against the world average grade of 4.69 at HL and **6** against the world average of 4.23 at SL. *Physics* students scored an average of 5.83 with the world average grade being 4.85. Computer Science students have dazzled at 7 against the world average of 4.53 at HL and 4.15 at SL

As we celebrate these exceptional results, it is important to remember that this milestone is just a part of their educational journey. IB education aims to prepare students to apply, to adapt, and to evolve. The experience goes far beyond exam scores. Every IBDP student has had to traverse through many unfamiliar and sometimes overwhelming experiences. It is these very experiences that help them face real-world challenges, making them resilient and adaptive. The true success of an IB student is their ability to be better critical thinkers, embrace new challenges, and cherish the lifelong journey of learning ahead of them.
